1. Church agrees to make available to Subscriber sufficient space(s) in Courtyard for the interment of the cremated remains stipulated above;
2. Church agrees to arrange for the opening and closing of the above-stipulated space(s);
3. Following an interment Church agrees to issue to the deceased's family a statement of interment.
4. Subscriber agrees to be strictly bound by the Policies, a copy of which is attached hereto, and which is incorporated herein by reference, along with any amendment or alterations made in Policies from time to time by Church.
5. The agreement is binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and successors of the parties herein named.
